
STATE SUMMARY: CALIFORNIA

NEW CRIMINAL CASES

California initiated 10 new criminal human trafficking cases in 2018, ranking it 5th in the nation for number of new cases.



ACTIVE CRIMINAL CASES

California had 47 criminal human trafficking cases active in 2018, ranking it 3rd in the nation for number of active cases.




CONVICTIONS

California convicted 42 defendants in human trafficking cases in 2018, ranking it 2nd in the nation for number of defendants convicted.

RESTITUTION

6 defendants ordered to pay restitution out of 26 convicted defendants.*

31.2%



California ordered **6** defendants to pay restitution in 2018, ranking it 3rd in the nation for restitution orders.

*16 of the convicted defendants were in cases where the government did not name a trafficking victim in the charging instrument. These defendants have been excluded for purposes of restitution calculations.


NEW CRIMINAL LABOR TRAFFICKING CASES

In 2018, federal courts in California filed criminal charges against 1 defendant in 1 labor trafficking case. California was 1 of only 7 states that initiated a criminal labor trafficking prosecution in 2018.

Nationally, the most common type of exploited labor in labor trafficking cases active in 2018 was domestic work.

NATIONAL NUMBERS





LIMITATIONS: The Report's findings are not a prevalence estimate of human trafficking in the United States but instead serve as an objective summary of what the federal system has done to address trafficking. The Report does not capture data from state prosecutions, state civil suits, or unreported human trafficking cases.
