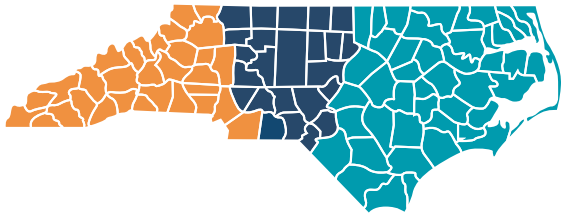

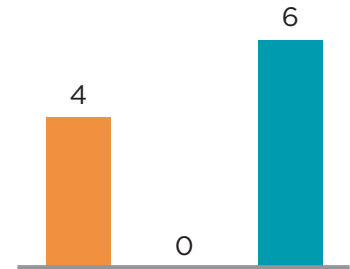

NEW CRIMINAL CASES

North Carolina initiated **3** new criminal human trafficking cases in 2018, ranking it 19th in the nation for number of new cases.



ACTIVE CRIMINAL CASES

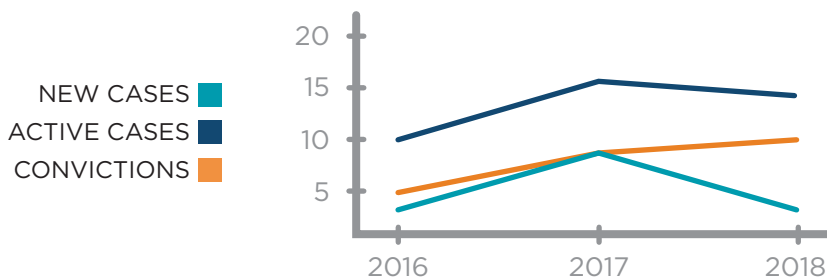
North Carolina had **14** criminal human trafficking cases active in 2018, ranking it 16th in the nation for number of active cases.



CONVICTIONS

North Carolina convicted **10** defendants in human trafficking cases in 2018, ranking it 10th in the nation for number of defendants convicted.

North Carolina ordered **5** defendants to pay restitution in 2018, ranking it 6th in the nation for restitution orders.

NEW CRIMINAL LABOR TRAFFICKING CASES

North Carolina was **1** out of **49** states and territories that failed to initiate a criminal labor trafficking prosecution in 2018.

Nationally, the most common type of exploited labor in labor trafficking cases active in 2018 was domestic work. Over half of the active labor trafficking cases involved a defendant using threats of deportation to coerce labor or services.
