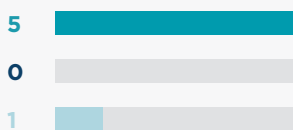


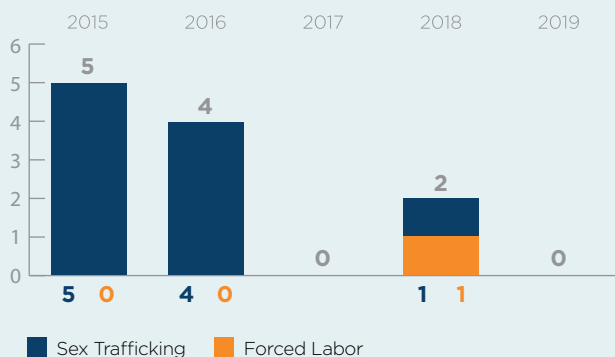

### NEW CRIMINAL CASES:

Federal prosecutors in Louisiana charged **0 new criminal human trafficking cases** in 2019, ranking it last in the nation for number of new cases.

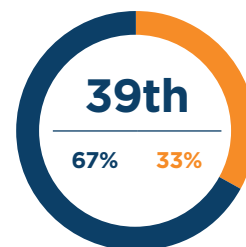
National new criminal cases: 145



### ACTIVE CRIMINAL CASES:

Federal courts in Louisiana handled **3 active criminal human trafficking cases** in 2019, ranking it 39th in the nation for number of active cases.

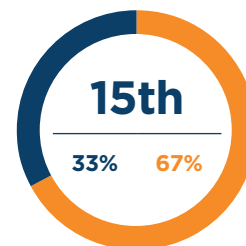
National active criminal cases: 606



### CONVICTIONS:

Federal courts in Louisiana convicted **6 defendants in human trafficking cases** in 2019, ranking it 15th in the nation for number of defendants convicted.

National convictions: 339



### RESTITUTION:

Federal judges in Louisiana ordered **5 out of 6 convicted defendants to pay restitution** in 2019, ranking it 6th in the nation for percentage of defendants ordered to pay restitution.

National restitution percentage: 33%

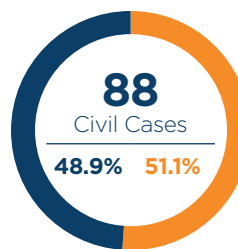

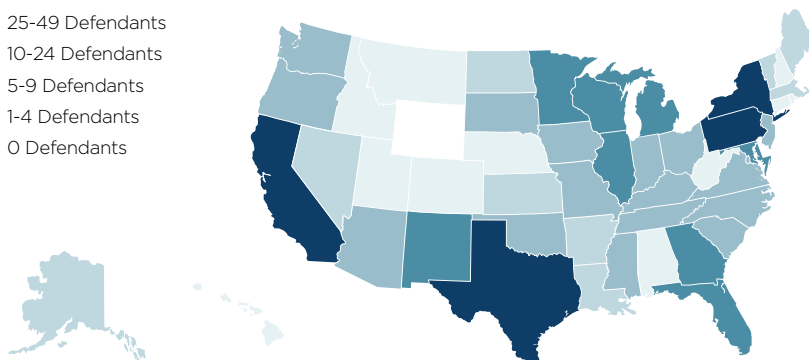
