NEW CRIMINAL CASES:

Federal prosecutors in Missouri charged **7 new criminal human trafficking cases** in 2019, ranking it 5th in the nation for number of new cases.

National new criminal cases: 145



ACTIVE CRIMINAL CASES:

Federal courts in Missouri handled **18 active criminal human trafficking cases** in 2019, ranking it 9th in the nation for number of active cases.

National active criminal cases: 606



CONVICTIONS:

Federal courts in Missouri convicted **9 defendants in human trafficking cases** in 2019, ranking it 10th in the nation for number of defendants convicted.

National convictions: 339



RESTITUTION:

Federal judges in Missouri ordered **2 out of 9 convicted defendants to pay restitution** in 2019, ranking it 24th in the nation for percentage of defendants ordered to pay restitution.

National restitution percentage: 33%

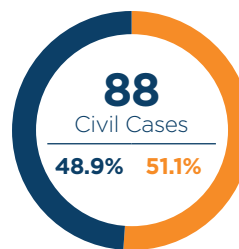

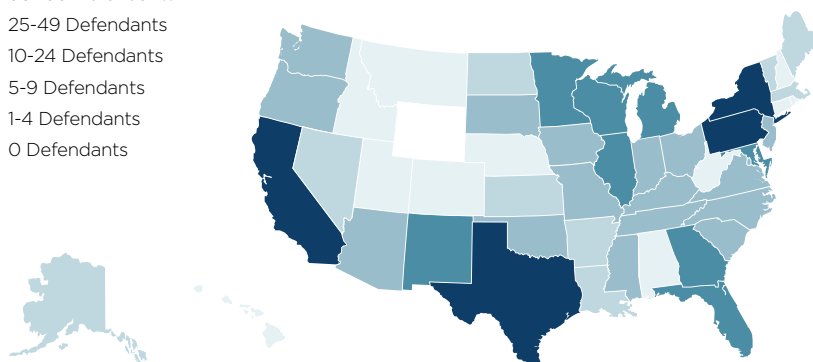
